

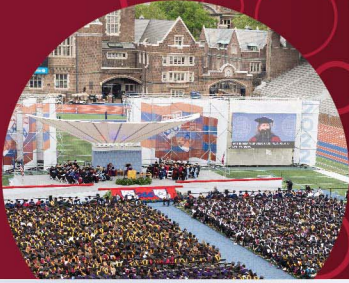

Please join us on Monday, May 15, 2023, for the University of Pennsylvania's 267th Commencement ceremony. The ceremony features the conferral of degrees, the awarding of honorary degrees, greetings by University officials, and a Commencement speaker, to be announced. Candidates for degrees in May 2023, as well as those who have completed degree requirements in August or December 2022, are encouraged to attend Commencement and to march in the procession. Academic regalia is required. Details about Commencement, including the ceremony and academic regalia, will be available at commencement.upenn.edu in early 2023.

COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY

Monday, May 15, 2023
Franklin Field, 33rd and South Streets
Gates will open at 8:30 a.m.

Degree candidates will assemble near the high rises at 39th & Locust Walk by 8:45 a.m. and enter Franklin Field at 9:30 a.m. The ceremony will begin at approximately 10:15 a.m., upon the arrival of the academic procession. The ceremony will be held rain or shine.

WEBCAST OF THE COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY

Those unable to attend Penn's 267th Commencement may view a live webcast of the ceremony. Coverage from Franklin Field will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, May 15.
