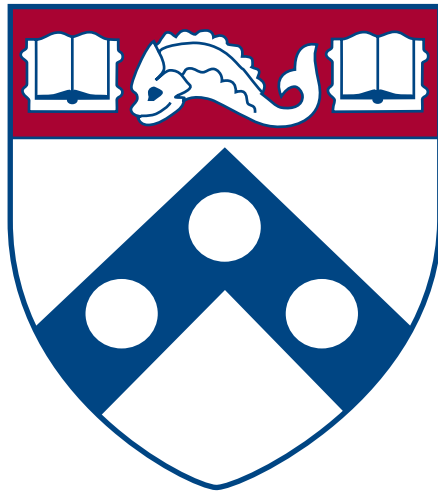

### **Brigid Dwyer, PhD**

*Vice Dean for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion, School of Arts and Sciences*

As the vice dean for diversity, equity, and inclusion, Brigid Dwyer, PhD, provides leadership in pursuit of the School's core commitments to achieving and maintaining excellence through diversity. She has 20 years of experience as a practitioner, scholar, and professor addressing issues of equity in higher education. Before joining Penn in 2021, she served as associate dean for diversity and inclusion at Princeton University, where she worked with a wide range of campus partners to develop and implement strategies, programs, and curricula that promoted an inclusive community.

Dr. Dwyer also spent seven years at Villanova University as Assistant Professor in the Departments of Education and Counseling and the Department of Communication and served as the Director of the Program on Intergroup Relations (IGR) and Assistant Director of Research & Training. Prior to her time at Villanova, Dr. Dwyer was an Adjunct Sociology Professor at Delaware County Community College.

Dr. Dwyer has published numerous articles and book chapters on the topics of diversity, equity, and inclusion, intergroup dialogue, leadership, and organizational culture and identity at minority-serving institutions.

She serves on the boards of the Difficult Dialogues National Resource Center, the New Leadership Academy, and Marin Academy High School.

Previously, Dr. Dwyer had a career in athletics. She served as an academic advisor, coach, and administrator at UCLA, University of Michigan, the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA), the Amateur Athletic Foundation of Los Angeles, and the Black Women in Sport Foundation. She was a 2000 Olympic Swimming Trials qualifier and an NCAA All-American. Presently, she consults with USA Swimming on their diversity, equity, and inclusion efforts.

Dr. Dwyer has a bachelor's degree in sociology from the University of California, Los Angeles, and a master's degree and a PhD from the Center for the Study of Higher and Postsecondary Education at the University of Michigan.

## The College of Liberal and Professional Studies

The University of Pennsylvania's founder, Benjamin Franklin, knew the importance of education. At the age of 10, in 1716, his formal education ended when his father took him out of school to become a chandler's apprentice, learning to make soap and candles. Young Ben disliked the work and eventually was apprenticed as a printer to his brother James, who brought a printing press from England.

While he learned the printing trade, Franklin borrowed books from the apprentice booksellers he came to know in Boston, his hometown. He was known to skip meals in order to buy books of his own. He taught himself not only grammar, arithmetic, and history, but several foreign languages, which served him well in his later years when he represented the fledgling United States government as ambassador to France.

The student of today who has had to interrupt, or never had the chance to begin, a college education—or who seeks further study in professional master's programs—has the option of earning an Ivy League degree through the University of Pennsylvania's College of Liberal and Professional Studies.
